Dear Superintendents, Principals, and Counselors:

The NDSCS Alumni Foundation is excited to again offer a \$150/class scholarship to students interested in taking online Early Entry classes!

Class size is limited so students should register as soon as possible. **Students will be enrolled on a first-come, first-served basis.** The classes are Early Entry classes (receive both high school & college credit). The student will pay \$202.33/college credit minus \$150 Foundation scholarship. Cost to the student will be **approximately** \$457 for a 3 credit class and \$660 for a 4 credit class. The classes will be offered on a semester basis, following the NDSCS calendar.

- Students are only allowed to take one class per semester at the reduced rate. Students may take additional online classes at the full rate of tuition.
- We can accept 5 students per class per school
- The student will be responsible for purchasing the books. If assistance is needed, please call the NDSCS bookstore 1-800-342-4325 ext. 32125 or 701-671-2125 or online <http://www.ndscsbookstore.com/>

Application for Admission:

If the student has never taken a class with NDSCS or has had a lapse in enrollment, he/she will need to complete the application for admission online (\$35 one-time non-refundable application fee if applying for the first time). When applying, students will select **"Early Entry Student"** as type of admission. The link to apply for admission: www.ndscs.edu/earlyentry

Please return the following to Dawn Knudson by **November 28, 2018:**

- NDSCS Course Registration – **signed by student and parent/guardian**
- FERPA Release Form – voluntary
- Copy of student's in-progress high school transcript if this is the first Early Entry course from NDSCS. It is recommended that students have a minimum GPA of 3.0. Request for Early Entry enrollment by students who do not have a GPA of 3.0 will be reviewed on an individual basis.

*****Please note: NDSCS cannot enroll a student in a spring semester course if tuition from a previous semester has not been paid in full.***

If a student qualifies for free or reduced meals, he/she may be eligible for financial assistance to pay for Early Entry courses. The BND Dual Credit Assistance Application can be found at www.ndscs.edu/earlyentry.
