Daniel Warcken, Superintendent went over the January budget, revenues, activity fund report, monthly bank accounts as presented.

Motion by Planteen seconded by Hoistad to approve the bills presented. Motion carried.

Superintendent's Report

Mr. Warcken, Superintendent reported 53 children currently active in the Imagination Library Program with 24 graduated, total that have gone through the program at 77, DRN completed networking switch work and provided updates in technology room, Site on Sound installed new ceiling mounted speakers in the old gym, Southside Automotive installed DVR system on Carol's bus #504, Superintendent evaluation due March 15th, working on overhauling and updating school's crisis management plan as last revision occurred in 2015, monthly Ottertail bill was high due to the extreme cold temperatures as of late, submitted Monsanto grant (\$25,000) for possible use of STEM SmartLab, school makeup days are February 15th (full day), March 15th (full day) which leaves 240 minutes to make up, 2019 E-rate application completed, AdvancED Engagement Review finished up with all three members providing many positive compliments, working with local candidate to fill elementary special education position through the UND Special Education Resident Teacher Program, preliminary 2019-2020 budget completed, upcoming committee meetings discussed.
